

Advanced Root Cause Analysis & Problem Solving Training Course Details

Overview

The 2-Day Advanced Root Cause Analysis & Problem Solving training course teaches key problem-solving techniques in order to uncover the underlying causes of problems that impact an organization's operations and ultimately its profitability.

- The first day of the course provides commonly used Root Cause Analysis tools necessary to determine and put in place meaningful corrective actions.
- The second day of the course goes deeper into multiple node problems, as well as focusing on exercises that
 pertain to the organization and/or industry.

Using a well-structured Case Study, real application examples, practical exercises, and role-playing audit scenarios; this course helps develop a hands-on understanding that will facilitate the uncovering of true root causes of problems and the implementation of meaningful corrective actions to help the organization improve.

Learning Objectives

By the end of the course, participants should have attained knowledge and understanding of the following concepts:

- The steps to properly solve a problem, whether a manufacturing or service problem.
- Detail overview of tools used for root cause analysis identification, including:
 - Brainstorming
 - o The 5 Whys
 - Cause & Effect Analysis
- How to formulate immediate and long-term corrective actions, to address the root causes and prevent the original problem from reoccurring.
- Checking effectiveness of actions taken.
- Techniques to use when dealing with non-linear problems, or problems with multiple root causes.
- The preparation, research, questions, and forensic work to solve deeper problems.
- The forms, spreadsheets, or tools to use when solving linear and multiple node problems.

Prerequisites

The Advanced Root Cause Analysis & Problem Solving training course does not have any prerequisite courses.
